Missionary report from the Baltic country of Lithuania

Our missionary, Marian Kozak preached and reported what Jesus is doing in their church plant in Lithuania. Our church sent this family over ten years ago.

It was exactly 25 years to the day since Marian trusted Jesus as Lord and Savior!

I personally disciplined this man - who was orphaned at 18 years of age. He states that it was being invited into our home, eating with us together and seeing how Christian followers of Jesus acted in their family that impacted him deeply. Taking him on a missions trip to Rumania opened his eyes and heart. Subsequently he felt called to fulltime ministry service as a church-planter in a foreign country.

Thorsten baptized

A man that Marian began discipling 20 years ago before going to Lithuania asked to be baptized and Marian baptized him on the Sunday he preached. Fruit often matures slowly in Europe. Twenty years!

In his testimony, Thorsten says that reading Ephesians moved his soul: Putting off the old man. He needed to give that full expression and die to himself - great testimony.

Philipp trusts Christ

Following the service on April 6th, I met with the couple Lilly and Phillip, who have asked me to perform their wedding.

I asked Phillip about having trusted Jesus with his soul. He confirmed that he was an agnostic. I explained in detail a concise plan of salvation from Romans. Philipp stated the he wanted to confess with his mouth and believe in his heart. It was a special time of prayer together. Lilly had tears of joy in her eyes.
