Missionary care

Our church has had the privilege to send out three missions teams - one to the Baltic nation of Lithuania, one to Kenya and one to Cambodia. In May we send a family as medical missionaries to Peru.

One of our roles as a sending church is encouragement and spiritual care. That put me in Phnom Penh, Cambodia at the beginning of March. What a challenge to fast and pray with our couple who struggle under the stresses of living in a developing culture. Ramona spoke from her heart when she stated: "I have English-speaking friends, but no one with whom I can speak my heart language (German)." It was a worthwhile investment to spend time with this couple.

Additionally, I visited Cambodian pastors working in jungle settings with Jan. I spoke at a college training Vietnamese and Cambodian students. Then we evangelized with the pastors. On that afternoon 17 people placed their trust in Jesus and were left in the care of a young church planter in the small village.

New Members and ministry

Four new families have been welcomed into the fellowship. Service attendance is stable and increasing. Soon we will need to find solutions for a lack of seating.

The daily expositional recordings of New Testament chapters continues. So far I have completed 5 books of the New Testament. To this point there have been over 2,500 individual downloads - all without any advertising at all. We have great opportunities to impact the German-speaking world as never before.

Next week I depart with a team of Germans to minister to my colleague Brian Weed in Nicaragua. Exposing our church to the great commission has always been a worthwhile investment.
